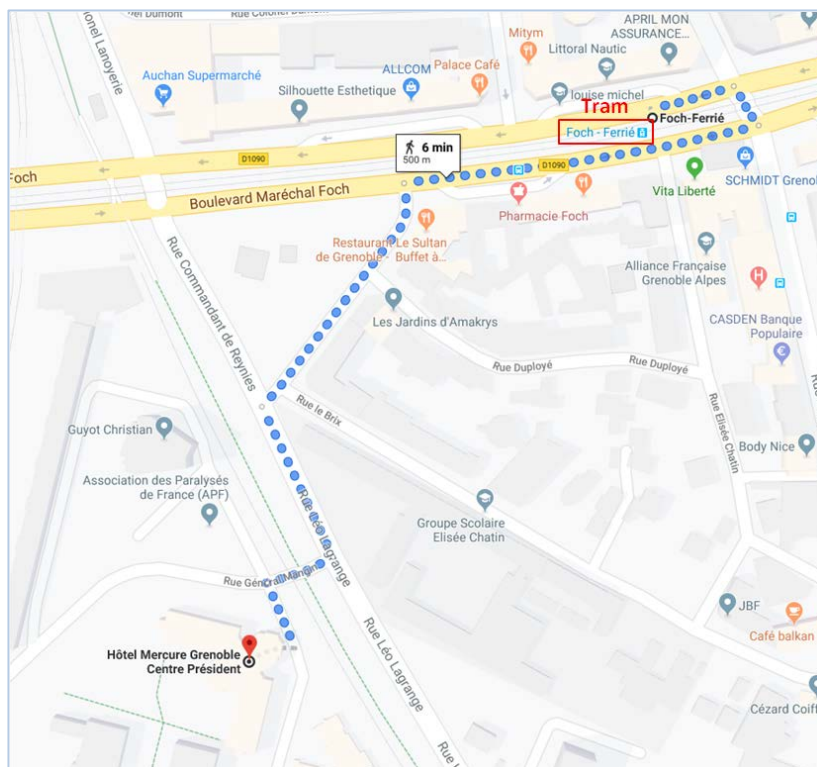


IMMW21 Delegate Information

Registration

Badges and workshop information will be distributed by the Local Organising Committee during the Welcome cocktail on Sunday, 23rd June and the morning of Monday, 24th June.

ESRF visit - Thursday, 27th June

Hotel Mercure Président -> ESRF:

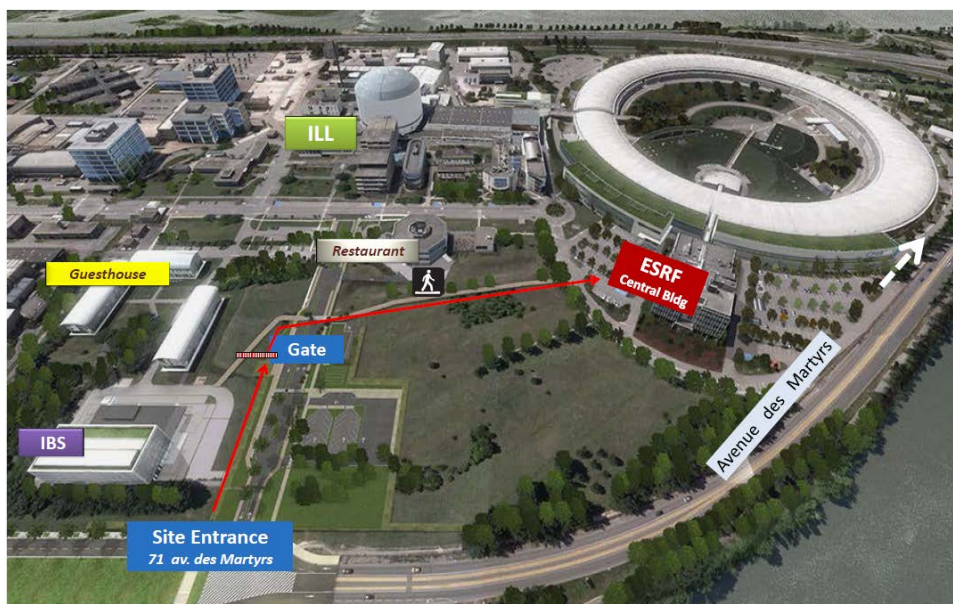
Take tram line C from the 'Foch-Ferrié' stop in the direction of 'Seyssins'. Get off at the 'Vallier Libération' stop. Take line E in the direction of 'Fontanil Cornillon Palluel'. Get off at the 'Alsace Lorraine' stop. Take line B to the terminus 'Grenoble Presqu'île' (recently renamed to 'Oxford' to celebrate 30 years of twinning between Grenoble and Oxford, UK). The terminus is located just 350m from the site entrance.



The EPN Campus is a restricted area and you should report in at the site entrance on arrival. Please state that you are attending the IMMW21 Workshop. You will need to produce proof of identification (passport or ID card only) to obtain a visitor's badge which you should wear at all times when on site.

Please aim to arrive at the site entrance at 08:00 to allow enough time for your badge to be processed.

Workshop presentations will start at 09:00 in the Auditorium of the ESRF Central Building (basement level).



Wi-Fi access at the ESRF:

- Via EPN Visitors:
Login: **e-mail address** (as registered in your ESRF User portal account)
Password (in lowercase): **SMIS password** used to access your ESRF User portal account.
- Via Eduroam network:
The ESRF and the ILL are eduroam-compliant: users who have a valid account in another eduroam compliant institution can use this network.

The ESRF facility tour includes a visit of the Insertion Devices Magnetic Measurement Laboratory, part of the new EBS tunnel and a beamline.

Delegates will be split into groups for the ESRF tour and the tour of the LNCMI. Please consult the IMMW21 notice board in the Entrance Hall of the ESRF Central Building to see which group you have been assigned to.

Coffee breaks will be held in the Entrance Hall of the ESRF Central Building. A 'Food truck' lunch will be served inside the Storage Ring. Access to the Storage Ring is restricted; please make sure that you stay with your group to be able to access the Storage Ring.

Social events

The Welcome cocktail will be held at the Hotel Mercure Président on Sunday, 23rd June, from 18:30 to 20:00.



The Workshop Dinner will take place at 19:30 on Wednesday, 26th June at Chez Le Pèr'Gras Restaurant, situated at 'La Bastille' fort which overlooks Grenoble.

'La Bastille' can be accessed by taking the Grenoble - Bastille cable car ('Gare du Téléphérique') from the 'Quai Stéphane Jay' (map reference: **9**).

Hotel Mercure Président -> Grenoble-Bastille cable car:

Take tram line C from the 'Foch-Ferrié' stop in the direction of 'Saint-Martin-D'Hères'. Get off at the 'Chavant' stop. Take line A in the direction of 'Fontaine La Poya' and get off at the 'Victor Hugo' stop (C3 on map). The cable car can be reached by crossing the 'Jardin de Ville' gardens.

We recommend that you arrive at the cable car departure point at 18:30 or earlier if you wish to visit 'La Bastille' before dinner.

You should state that you are attending a dinner at the Pèr'Gras restaurant and show your workshop badge to get free access to the cable car. The cable cars leave every 5 minutes and take between 5 and 8 minutes to climb up to the fort. The restaurant is sign posted at the top and is a 600m walk from there. The cable cars stop at midnight.
